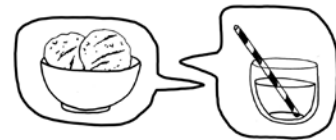

- Where in Italy did the world's first pizzeria open?
a) Naples

ANSWERS: 1. In 1830, the world's first pizzeria, named *Port'Alba*, opened in Naples, Italy. The pizzas were cooked in an oven lined with lava from Mount Vesuvius, a volcano located on the Bay of Naples.
2. Pizza dough is generally made of flour, water, yeast and salt.
3. South America. Native to Peru and Ecuador, the tomato plant was introduced to Europe in the early 1500s.
4. More than 5 billion pizzas are sold worldwide each year, and an estimated 350 slices are eaten each second.
